



Corporate Overview



Mack manufactures high quality, complex parts, assemblies and total products in plastic and metal for the medical, commercial, computer & business equipment, consumer electronics and transportation markets.

- Mack is a full-service contract manufacturer that specializes in custom injection molding, metal fabrication and assembly up to and including FDA approved medical device manufacturing services in ISO 9001, ISO 13485, ISO 14001 and Class 100,000 clean room environments. Product development resources include device and product design, prototyping and extensive engineering services.
- A privately held corporation, Mack was founded in 1920 in Little Falls, N.J.
- With nearly 90 years of experience in custom injection molding, Mack offers solid injection, gas assist, structural foam, overmolding and two-shot molding, as well as extensive secondary operations. Overall press count totals 120, with tonnage ranging from 28–4,000 tons.
- At its Southern Division, Mack focuses on large part molding, with 21 of its 40 injection molding machines in the 1000–4000 ton range. Primary markets for its large tonnage presses include heavy truck parts, recreational and utility vehicles, structural HVAC applications, large screen TVs, and medical devices.
- Mack offers full-service plastics prototyping and low volume manufacturing through Mack Prototype, Inc., in Gardner, Massachusetts. Specialties include engineering analysis, rapid prototyping for both small and large parts, polyurethane molding, CNC machining, extensive finishing operations, tooling and small-part injection molding.
- Mack also has a fully equipped metal fabrication facility that includes CNC sheet metal machining centers for punching, forming and laser cutting, along with CNC press brakes and a host of auxiliary equipment, including laser welding. Mack’s sheet metal operation produces 19-inch rack enclosures for data storage, on-site solar compaction systems, chassis for various medical devices, and a significant number of cases and trays for medical instrumentation and surgical equipment OEMs.
- Today, Mack operates 10 locations throughout Vermont, Massachusetts, North Carolina, South Carolina, Florida and Mexico, totaling 1.5 million square feet of manufacturing space.
- Mack has earned a 5A1 D&B rating, the highest available. The corporation has no long-term debt, and finances its own acquisitions and growth.
- Annual sales are approximately \$300 million. Mack has more than 1900 employees worldwide.
