He was also a member of the Knights of Columbus and the Alexandria Township Parks and Recreation Committee.

Walck joined Mack in 2000 as a new business development manager. He was promoted to director in 2006. He previously was national sales manager for Polycel Structural Foam Plastics Inc. in Somerville, N.J.

He was a graduate of Raritan Valley College in Somerset, N.J., having completed graduate coursework in marketing and business administration.
